

Question - Can you give me contact details for other creditors?

Response – Our overriding duty, as Joint Administrators, is to the two Companies in administration and their creditors as a whole. We have no objection to creditors communicating with each other and establishing informal groups.

Within eight weeks of our appointment we will produce a summary of the administration proposals for the two Companies. This report (sometimes referred to as the para 49 report) will be sent to all creditors. It will include (as an appendix) a list of the names and addresses of all the known creditors.

A number of people have contacted us expressing an interest in establishing contact with other creditors (generally in the same development).

The Joint Administrators consider that they are not in a position to give out personal contact details of creditors without their specific consent.

However, we will be happy to consider forwarding on email contact details to other creditors, on receipt of a written request. This request must be provided to us by email, fax or post (not telephone).

The email addresses provided will be circulated on a weekly basis only to other creditors of the same development who have submitted an equivalent request. The frequency of this circular is subject to revision at the sole discretion of the Joint Administrators.
